COVID 19 Daily Brief – 20th May

Alongside the ongoing site wide tasks & as part of the site restart programme, OneAIM will restart the SRP project on Thursday, which as a reminder:

“the SRP is the second of the SL sites to restart work after our pause on construction, which started at the end of March when lockdown restrictions hit.

Its importance to our overall mission was highlighted when it was named as one of 11 vital pieces of work picked to head our restart plans. It follows the successful restart of our Box Encapsulation Plant Project Store Direct Import Facility (BEPPS-DIF) and has put similar measures in place to maintain workplace distancing.

SRP is delivered through our Programme and Project Partners (PPP) model and is the first within PPP to restart, with our partners working closely with us to enable a successful transition back to work”.

The first work to be restarted on SRP will be the steel fixings for the concrete slab, work which can be effectively done whilst keeping distances of at least two metres.

All arrangements will be monitored so learning can be shared with other projects coming back on-line and to strengthen those at SRP if necessary.

SL Enterprise Risk Assessment Update

As part of the ongoing review SL have:

- Reviewed all 8 guidance documents released by HMG on 11 May.
- Clarified and articulated the hierarchy of controls
- Realigned some terms to match HMG guidance (no material change)
- Realigned references and links to the new guidance.
- Signed Covid-19 Secure Policy Statement
- Issued a Note for the Record – Issue 2 to Issue 3

The OSW Risk Assessments will similarly reflect the key changes to our own workplace processes and arrangements. We can all help reduce risks by being aware of our surroundings and of the advice on maintaining workplace distancing wherever possible, maintaining good hygiene and ensuring that conventional safety controls remain in place.
