C19 – Holiday Planning & PPN04

The UK government has imposed a 14-day self quarantine on all arrivals from the Spanish region.

Personnel who are planning holidays for the future, should be aware that where a country has a designated quarantine requirement, then it is unlikely that any payment for wages during the mandatory 14-day quarantine period will be paid under the PPN04 notice.

All personnel should seek independent advice prior to booking, or for any bookings currently pending with the respective travel provider.

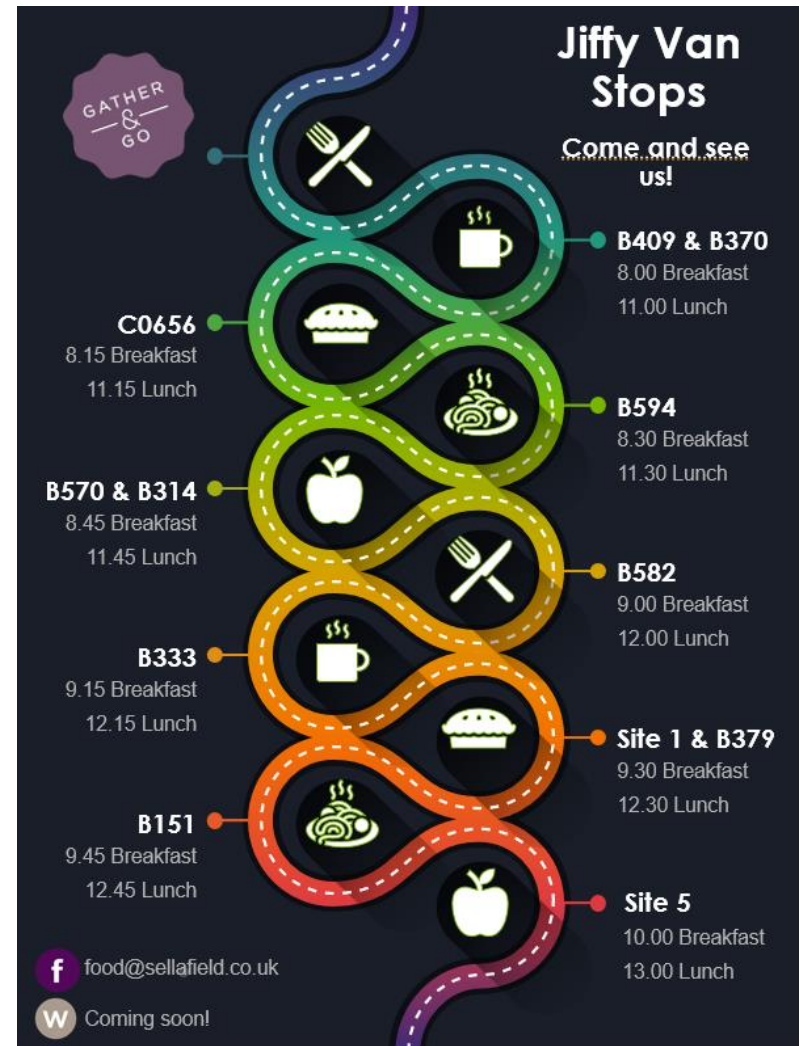

Under PPN04/20 all personnel are required to be available for work and remain contactable during normal working hours.

Where personnel cannot be contacted, or do not attend the workplace per the worklist restart arrangement then they will be registered as absent without permission until contact is re-established.
