COVID 19 Daily Brief – 18th June

WAMAC Gate:

Due to the increase in traffic accessing site via Main Gate the decision has been made to reopen WAMAC Gate during the in-muster period to alleviate traffic congestion:

As of the 22/06/2020 between the hours of 06:30hrs – 08:30hrs (Mon – Fri) WAMAC gate will be operational and allow access to authorised vehicles (private vehicles less than 5m in length, motorcycles, and bicycles)

HSA1:

Sector H (St12 North) – Due to the increase in traffic accessing HSA1 via Sector L (St12 South) the decision has been made to reopen Sector H (St12 North) to ease congestion on the site roads.

Street 12 Vehicle access arrangements will change to the times stated below from 22/06/2020 at 06.00hrs

The only exception will be for emergency response vehicles.

Sector H - ST12 North	M-F 06.00-15.00 (Access ONLY)
Sector L - ST12 South	06.00-15.00 Weekdays (Egress ONLY) 15.00-06.00 Weekdays (Access and Egress) Sat & Sun 24/7 (Access and Egress)
